Spanning over 41 square miles, South Brunswick Township is located in central New Jersey and home to about 46,000 residents. South Brunswick is composed of five main towns: Dayton, Kendall Park, Deans, Monmouth Junction and Kingston.

Home to picturesque parks, an esteemed school district and thriving businesses, South Brunswick Township provides countless opportunities for families and firms. We have 22 developed parks and trail systems for residents to enjoy.

South Brunswick has achieved many awards; our South Brunswick Police was the first township department in New Jersey to be dually certified – achieving prestigious state and national accreditation. In 2016, SafeWise ranked our township as the 10th Safest City to Raise a Child in America and in 2011 CNN Money ranked South Brunswick as the 22nd Best Place to Live in America. Even our National Night Out event ranked 5th among the National Association of Town Watch for National Night Out events across the country.

South Brunswick is intersected by I-95 NJ Turnpike, Route 27, and Route 1. We are located 47 miles from New York City and 52 miles from Philadelphia. Access to the city is easily accessible with the Park and Ride – located at the intersection of Route 32 and Route 130 – which provides bussing to and from New York City Port Authority, Grand Central, Manhattan’s East Side, Downtown Manhattan and Wall Street.

Nevertheless, South Brunswick is a modern and diverse suburban community which lives up to its slogan “Crossroads of Progress.”
