EMERALD ASH BORER – Public Information Presentation

When: Wednesday, April, 12, 2017, at 7:30 p.m.

Where: South Brunswick Senior Center, # 540 Ridge Rd., Monmouth Junction

(Municipal complex rear)

The Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) has recently been identified in South Brunswick and confirmed by the N.J. Dept. of Agriculture and the Twp. Shade Tree Commission.

This invasive insect will attack all Ash trees (*Fraxinus* sp.) resulting in their death within 3-5 years. The impact on both private and public trees will be significant. Dead and dying Ash trees become brittle, posing a future hazard to both life and property.

Property owners and neighborhoods with Ash trees are encouraged to attend. Mitigation options and action plans will be presented by the Twp. Shade Tree Commission.
