# Recommended items to include in a Basic Shelter Supply Kit:

- ❑ Prescription medications with instructions (in original containers)
- ❑ Eye glasses and/or contact lenses
- ❑ Hearing aid with extra batteries & dentures
- ❑ Emergency contact information, including physician, out of state personal contact
- ❑ File of Life (if you have one)
- ❑ Identification and health insurance cards
- ❑ Cell phone and chargers
- ❑ Infant formula and diapers
- ❑ Pet food for service dogs only
- ❑ Complete change of clothing, including a long sleeved shirt, long pants and sturdy shoes
- ❑ Feminine supplies and personal hygiene items
- ❑ House keys
- ❑ Paper and pencil
- ❑ Books, games, puzzles or other activities for children
